Nature Center Admission Fees (Pre-k through College)

Homeschool Groups (Self-guided)

- City of Asheville Homeschool: \$4 per student or adult
- Non-city resident Homeschool: \$5 per student or adult

Public & Private Schools (Self-guided)

- City of Asheville Schools: \$4 per student or adult
- Non-city resident Schools: \$5 per student or adult
- *School staff (teachers, aides, professional bus drivers) are free*

Guided Program Fee (add this to the Admission Fee above)

• \$1 per program per student or adult chaperone

Creature Feature: Interactive classroom experiences with live animals
